



No-Sew Fleece Blanket Instructions

Purchase 4 yards of Fleece fabric

Step #1: Purchase four yards of fleece fabric, then:

Cut the fabric into two, 2 yard (6 foot long) pieces. Place the 2 pieces of fleece one on top of each other, squaring up the edges to match/trim as needed. There will be two rough or curled edges called "selvage edges"; you can trim them off or leave them as part of the fringe. (If your fleece has a right and wrong side, put the wrong sides together)

Step #2:

Cut a five inch square from each corner of the fleeces ~ cut both layers together.

Step #3:

Tape a line with masking tape 5 inches away from the edge of the blanket (parallel to the edge), on all 4 sides.

Step #4:

Cut 5" long x 1" wide fringe around blanket, each side ~ again, cutting both layers together.

Step #5:

Tie the blanket knots by taking the 2 pieces of fringe (top and bottom) and tie the top fringe over the bottom fringe, and the bottom fringe over the top fringe. The idea is to bring the complimentary color fringe to the top of the blanket. Do not tie your knots too tight.....and the blanket can be stretched when all sides are tied.
